### **Phase 1 Park renovation to begin!**



#### Play Park

**We are delighted to say that Kompan will commence work on the play park on Saturday September 4<sup>th</sup>.**

**This will mean that the pedestrian park entrance, the play park area and the tarmacked area will be fenced off and inaccessible.**

**A section of the car park will also be closed to create a compound area during the construction works.**

**It is anticipated that the works will last approximately one month.**

On school days this car park usually serves as a safe and convenient place for parents to drop off and collect children, so parents may need to find alternative parking places whilst the improvements are taking place. We apologise for the inconvenience. You will have noticed a 'No Overnight Parking' sign has been erected at the entrance to the car park. We would like to request that residents abide by this rule and are considerate to other users.

#### Sensory Garden
